

Report - 3rd International Diabetes Summit 2019

The 3rd International Diabetes Summit -2019 was organized by Chellaram Diabetes Institute from **8th – 10th March 2019** at Hotel J W Marriot, Pune.

The 3-day mega event comprised of a Pre-conference workshop on Management of the Diabetic Lower Limb Neuropathy, various workshops on Insulin, NAFLD etc, symposiums, scientific CME on digital diabetology and the scientific sessions covering diabetes complications and its management in day to day life.

The summit was a grand success with more than **2000 attendees**. The conference was inaugurated by Dr Deelip Mhaisekar, Honourable Vice Chancellor of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences. About **50 speakers from India** and **10 international faculty** from US and Europe and **110 chairpersons** contributed to the success of this event.
